***SAH Annual International Conference
Fellowship***

The SAH Annual International Conference Fellowship helps a graduate student or emerging professional in architectural history or historic preservation attend the Annual International Conference of the Society of Architectural Historians. The fellowship includes an award of up to \$1000 to support travel and attendance at the SAH Annual International Conference. The fellowship also includes the member-rate, general registration fee.

Criteria for the SAH Annual International Conference Fellowship are:

- Applicants must be members of SESAH.
- **Student applicants** must be enrolled in a Masters or PhD program in architectural history or historic preservation, or a similar program, at a college or university located in the twelve-state geographic region embraced by SESAH. (Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, and Virginia).
- **Emerging professional applicants** must be within five years of having received a terminal degree (MA, MS, PhD) and must be working in historic preservation (or a related field) in the twelve-state geographic region embraced by SESAH.
- While persons not presenting a paper at the SAH Annual International Conference are encouraged to apply, preference will be given to applicants on the conference program.

Fellowship applications should include the following materials:

- A statement (not to exceed two pages, typed and double-spaced) explaining how the applicant's studies or professional work will be enhanced by attendance at the SAH Annual International Conference.
- Budget for travel costs, hotel, and meals. Also include source(s) and amount of other potential funding. *Note:* Reimbursements follow per diem rates, Breakfast - \$11, Lunch - \$12, Dinner \$23.
- Curriculum vitae.
- Letter of recommendation from the applicant's primary faculty advisor (the letter should include the advisor's name, e-mail, and telephone number) or other professional reference (for emerging professionals).
